

DIAGNOSIS

Late preterm(36W) 24/12/2020 , 07:25pm/NVD/LBW(2.2KG)/Outborn(kharbanda hospital)/Female/Mild RD/ Shock / PDA/ Feed intolerance / NNH

PRESENTING COMPLAINTS

Late preterm(36W) 24/12/2020 , 07:25pm/NVD/LBW(2.2KG)/Outborn(kharbanda hospital)/Female. Baby cried immediately after birth, but developed mild RD, hence referred to our centre for further management.

HISTORY OF PRESENTING ILLNESS

Late preterm(36W) 24/12/2020 , 07:25pm/NVD/LBW(2.2KG)/Outborn(kharbanda hospital)/Female. Baby cried immediately after birth, but developed RD, hence referred to our centre for further management.

EXAMINATION FINDING

O/E -
GC - Mordrate RD
CVS- Acrocynosis. Peripheries cold. HR 160/min.
RS- RR 80/min. AEBE. Subcostal retractions.Spo2 - 85%. Silverman Anderson Score 6.
Abdo - Soft, no distension
CNS- Af at level.Age appropriate

COURSE IN THE HOSPITAL

Baby received via ambulance.Downe score =3.Started on HHHFNC support immediately.
RDS- Started on HHHFNC support. RD settled by 72hours . HHHFNC support weaned & stopped by day 4. Baby is maintaining saturation on room air since past 24hrs with out any signs of RD.
Shock : On admission baby was pale in colour, CFT>3sec , bolus given over 1 hours. Inj dobutamine gien for 24 hours and tapered over 1 day and stopped. Threerafter perfusion was good.
Sepsis - Baby was hemodynamically stable. 2 Septic screen more than 48 hrs apart were negative. IV antibiotics were given for 4 days.
PDA : 3D ECHO done of day2 s/o - PDA (1mm). Clinically baby improved over 3days. No repeat ECHO was required.
NNH: Phototherapy given as per protocol.
Feeds- Baby was kept NPO for 1 day. Trophic feeds were started on day2 but baby had mild feed intolerance (1-2 vomitings)hence antibiotics were continued and minimal feeds given. Feeds were gradually built up to full feeds by 4thday. Currently on adlib feeds(tolerating well).
Urine & motion passed with 24 hrs of life.
Baby might need further stay in hospital for another 2 weeks.
